Memorandum of Understanding for Academic Cooperation Between Department of Commerce, JDSG College and Mariani College

Department of Commerce, JDSG College and Mariani College recognize their respective concerns for research and education in the discipline of commerce and management, and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic cooperation.

Department of Commerce, JDSG College and Mariani College, therefore agree to establish a programme for academic cooperation in the areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum of understanding (MOU).

1. Objectives

The goal is to foster collaboration and to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best efforts, mutual benefit, and frequent interactions. Department of Commerce, JDSG College and Mariani College agree:

- (a) To exchange information on research and educational programmes;
- (b) To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other factors relevant to their educational and research programmes;
- (c) To jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein;
- (d) To jointly organize seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein;
- (e) To jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein;
- (f) To exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students at undergraduate levels for limited periods of time for purpose of education and/or research.

Department of Commerce, JDSG College and Mariani College further agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be separately determined and agreed upon by the two institutions.

2. Joint Sponsored Research & Development

Department of Commerce, JDSG College and Mariani College agree to help identify and invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in research or development programmes.

3. Exchange of Faculty

Department of Commerce, JDSG College and Mariani College agree to encourage collaboration between faculty members from the two institutions. Specifically,

5. Exchange of Scientific and Technical Material



This MOU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for five years and may be continued thereafter after mutual review and agreement.


7. Dispute Clause



Article 3

The type, scope and manner of implementation of the respective fields of cooperation in Article 2 will be further specified in any separate agreements to this Agreement.

Article 5
