

NATIONAL FARMERS DAY

NSS Unit, Mariani college, Mariani, celebrated the “National Farmer’s Day” on 23rd Dec, 2022 in its adopted Village “Panchuwal”. The Event was organised under the guidance of the Programme Officer, Ms Kritika Agarwal and Ms Archana Saikia, Assistant Professor, Mariani College. 20 NSS volunteers took active part in the programme. The programme was inaugurated by Ms Kritika Agarwal at around 10:00 am. Next, a meeting with the local Farmers was organised in the Panchuwal LP School in presence of Ranjit Saikia, Gaon Pradhan of the Village, Arun Chutiya, Principal of the school, Sikhamoni Bordoloi, Asst. Principal, Rupali Chutia, Anganbadi Head, Sadhan Bakti, a farmer and Sumi Gogoi, a farmer, along with few other farmers of that Village. The objective of the meeting was to identify the issues that the farmers are facing in farming as well as other general problems existing in the village. During the meeting, Gaon Pradhan of the Village, Ranjit Saikia, Principal of the school, Arun Chutiya, and the farmers were felicitated with a ‘Phulam Gamosa’ by the NSS Volunteers. Mr Sadhan Bakti, a farmer of that Village pointed out their Problems in the meeting on the behalf of all farmers. He pointed out the unavailability of irrigation facility in that village. Another farmer of that Village named Sumi Gogoi, talked about the unavailability of updated technologies of farming and lack of training and Skills among the farmers. Miss Neha Agarwalla, NSS Volunteer, on behalf of all the volunteers showed some gratitude towards the farmers and mentioned the aims of the Visit to that Village along with a commitment to help them to overcome their problems. For the next agenda, household survey, the volunteers were divided into 5 groups and each group visited different households and conducted a Survey regarding the problems faced by them. The Volunteers of the unit, Bibhuty Beriya and Aditya Singh co-ordinated the whole activity. The total households as mentioned by the Gaon Pradhan was 114. 30 house (25%) was selected randomly to collect the data due to time constraint. The event ended by 5.30pm.
