PROGRAMMES ORGANISED BY WOMEN'S STUDY CELL:

District Level Students' Seminar, 28th June, 2017:

The Women's Study Cell, Mariani College organized a District Level Students' Seminar on 28th June, 2017, for the students of Higher Secondary and College level of Jorhat District.. The Theme of the seminar was "Population Growth & Environmental Degradation". Dr. Minakshi Phookan Hazarika, Associate Professor & HOD of Department of Geography, J.B. College, Jorhat, was invited as the Resource Person for the Seminar. Twenty (20) papers were selected for presentation in the two technical sessions. The technical sessions were chaired by Mr. Sisir Borthakur, Retd. Principal & HOD of Department of Geography, Mariani College and Dr. Ashim Borpatra Gohain, Associate Professor & HOD, Commerce, Mariani College. The presentations were followed by interactive Q&A sessions, which facilitated development of greater clarity of various environmental issues and also various innovative steps to maintain the environmental balance. The participants with best papers were given cash prizes.



Bhupendra Sangeet Competition, 8th September, 2017:

The Women's Study Cell, in association with Literary Forum, Mariani College celebrated the Birth Anniversary of Dr. Bhupen Hazarika on 8th September, 2017. On this occasion, a district level competition on Bhupendra Sangeet was organised among the students of the schools and colleges of Jorhat District. Training Programme on Personal Grooming, 20-22 March, 2018:

The Women's Study Cell, Mariani College, organized a Three-Day Training Programme on Personal Grooming for the female students of the college. A total of 112 students from all the three semesters participated in the programme. The programme was organised to create awareness among the girls about the importance of personal grooming and how proper grooming can boost the confidence level of a person.

Ms. Pinky Das, Beautician, alongwith her four assistants, were invited to provide training to the girls. Ms. Pinky Das covered various areas of personal grooming in the three-day programme. On the first day, the

instructor gave lessons on Hair Care like Hair Cut, Hair Spa, Hair Style, etc. On the second day, various aspects on face care like Facial, Threading, Make-up, etc. were taken care of. The various methods to body care such as wax, body massage, manicure, pedicure, etc. were tought on the last day. The participants were given practical training on all the three-days. The instructor said that with proper training and practice, the Beautician course can become a profitable self-employment avenue for the girls.




Farewell Programme for the
