

ACTIVITIES OF WOMEN CELL SINCE ITS FORMATION ON 15TH
DECEMBER, 2003

1. A free medical camp was organized by the Women Cell for health check-up of the poor people of Mariani and its surrounding areas on 2nd August, 2008. Free medicines were distributed among the needy people.
2. The members of Women Cell took up a survey to find out the health condition of the tea garden labour families of Kothagoorie Tea Estate in the year 2005. The study revealed that high blood pressure is the major health issue found among these people and the main causes found for this is high intake of salt in regular food and lack of nutritious food.
3. Another survey on "Socio-Economic Condition of the people of Majuli" was made in the year 2006 by the members of Women Cell. Soil erosion was identified as the major problem for the people of this area.
4. A vocational training programme was organized by the Cell in the year 2007 to provide training to the unemployed youths of Mariani. The programme provided training on doll making, embroidery and fabric to 20 unemployed youths of Mariani.
5. In 2008, the members of Women Cell conducted a field study on the problems of the people of nearby village 'Balijan Shyam Gaon' in Jorhat district. The study found out that the main problem of the villagers is lack of safe drinking water facility. The Women Cell, in collaboration with the ONGCL, Cinnamara, installed two tube wells in the village.
6. The Cell also organized a General Health Check up Camp in 2009 in Balijan Shyam Gaon, in which 10 doctors from different departments provided free service to the villagers. Around 750 people of the village and nearby villages attended the camp and free medicines were distributed to the needy people. Along with the medical camp, the Cell also organized drawing competition and essay competition among the children of the village and in the end prizes were distributed among the winners.
7. The Cell organized a Spoken English Course for the students of the college in 2009. Mr. Dipak Dutta was the instructor of the course and 80 students successfully participated in the course.
8. The members of Women Cell planted various trees in the College Campus in 2010.
9. In 2010, the Cell organized a talk on Laws in Support of Women, in which government lawyer Ms. Mira Baruah was invited as the Resource person.
10. The Cell organized a Diabetes Awareness Camp on 13th February, 2011, in which free blood sugar test was done for the people of Mariani.
11. On International Women's Day, the Cell organized a free eye check up camp in collaboration with Lions Club, Jorhat, in the college campus. 110 people from Mariani and nearby areas participated in the Camp out of which 14 cataracts patients were identified. The cataract patients were given free operation facility by the Lions Club and also free medicines were given to the needy people.

12. The Cell organized a Free Ear Screening Camp on 21st September, 2013, in which 48 people of Mariani and surrounding areas participated.
13. An Awareness Camp on Breast Cancer was organized by the Cell for the female students of the college on 12th October, 2013, in which Cancer specialist of Jorhat, Dr. Bihari Agarwal delivered his speech on the causes of breast cancer and the cautions to be taken to avoid this disease and also techniques for early detection of breast cancer.
14. A talk on "Health and Food Habit of Women" by Dr. Munin Goswami was organized by the Women Cell for the female students on 12th November, 2013.
15. International Women's Day, 2014 was celebrated by the Cell by planting trees in the College Campus by the members.
16. On International Women's Day, 2015, the members of the Cell visited the "Observation Home" of Jorhat Central Jail. The Cell organized various activities for the 24 juvenile inmates of the Observation Home. An Art competition was organized for these children and prizes for the winners, books and food items were distributed among them.
17. Bishnu Rabha Divas was celebrated on 20th June, 2015 by the Women Cell in the College Campus. Bishnu Rabha Sangeet competition and recitation on Bishnu Rabha poem among the students of the college was organized by the Cell.
