ACTIVITIES 1: GOLDEN JUBLIE CELEBRATION 2016

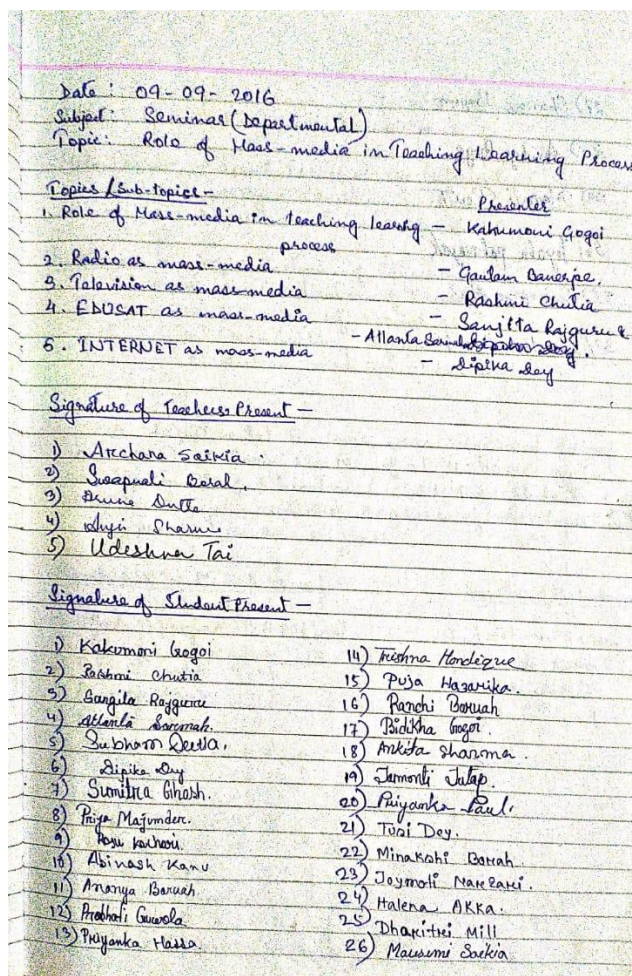
Date: 1st July, 2016

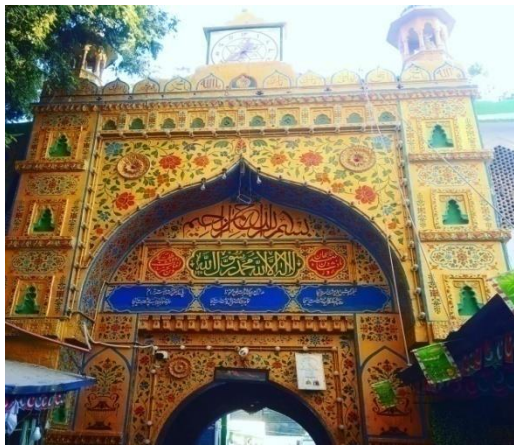


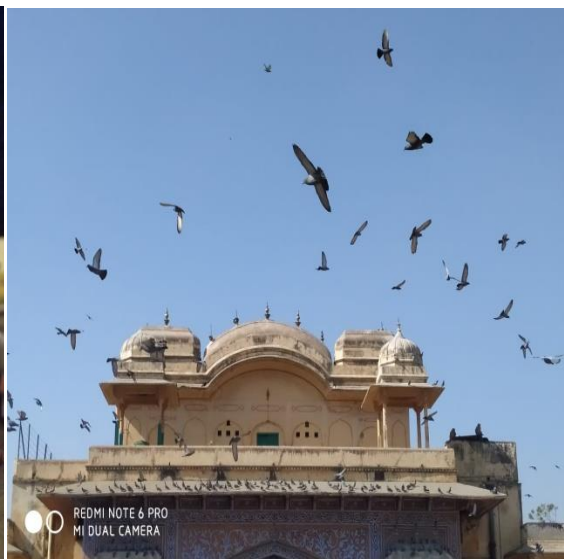


ACTIVITIES 7: EDUCATIONAAL TOUR AND EXCURSION JAIPUR

Online Class:
