A Roadmap for the innovative program executed under the clauses of the Memorandum of Understanding with UMA Global, Inc., New York Metropolis

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This Roadmap provides the framework for joint actions directed to the students and the faculty members of Mariani College, in relation to the development of a Leadership Development Program, in collaboration with UMA Global Inc, New York, to curate and design curricula and initiatives to develop the leadership skills of the faculty members, and teaching students.

In this roadmap, there will be two phases. The first phase will be to provide leadership development overview sessions to a cohort of 15-20 students from various degree disciplines, through 6 sessions, 1 hour each, via the online medium Zoom. The agenda is given below, and will commence on Tuesday, 4th March, 2025 with an introductory session where Dr. Rita Kakati-Shah, President of Uma Global will address the students. The online sessions will enable the students to be guided on various leadership qualities, such as Confidence, Communications, the Art of Persuasion, Entrepreneurship and Global Business, Sustainability and the United Nations, and gender equality, and so forth.

The agenda / Topics to be covered is set forth here:

- 2. Week 2: Confidence and Leadership
- 3. Week 3: Communication and Social Skills
- 4. Week 4: Negotiation/ Art of Persuasion and Collaboration
- 5. Week 5: Entrepreneurship, Global Business and Productivity
- 6. Week 6: UN SDGs Sustainability and Gender Equality

The eventual goal of the leadership program is to develop the 21st-century skills of the students through interactive and experiential learning techniques, through a two-semester course with credit into the curriculum (skills, value-added) to improve confidence, communication, social skills, global ways of thinking, sustainability, and productivity to improve the students and faculty members overall employability, and career prospects to ultimately benefit Assam's economy and reverse the concept of "Brain Drain".




Day 1: 9.30PM, Tue 4th Mar, Intro, Get to Know You

Day 2: 8.30PM, Tue 11th Mar, Confidence


On the second day, the Resource Persons taught the participants how to talk and face life situations confidently. The participants were asked to give a short speech on certain topics.






Day 3: 8.30PM, Tue 18th Mar, Communications


Day 4: 8.30PM, Tue 26th Mar, Negotiation/Art of Persuasion


Day 5: 8.30PM, Tue 1st Apr, Entrepreneurship & Global Business




Day 6: 8.30PM, Tue 8th Apr, UN SDGs - Sustainability & Gender Equality
