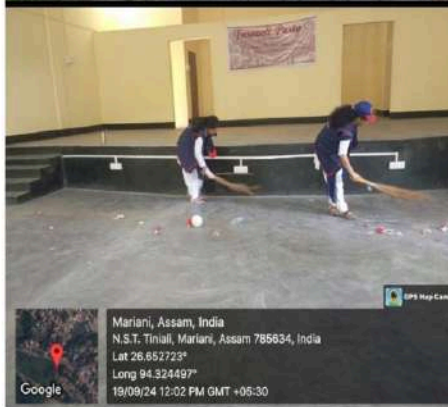

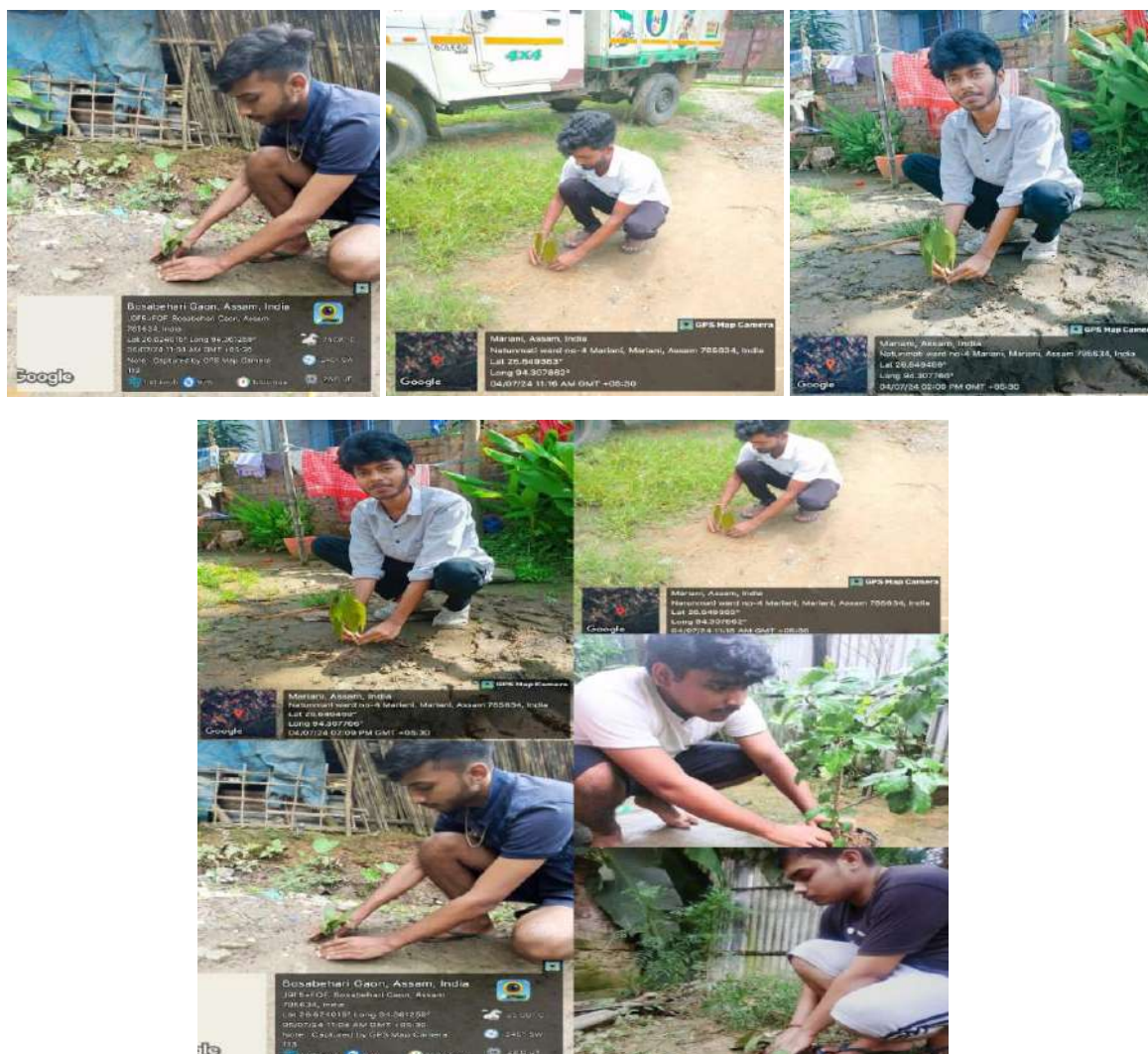
The programme successfully concluded at 2:00 pm.
