IT WAS in the year 1966, Mariani College was established by the sincerest initiatives of a good number of benevolent public and academicians of greater Mariani region. It was a humble effort for imparting higher education in a large locality, flanked mostly by Tea Gardens and villages. Establishment of Mariani College is a very vital and important addition in the academic scenario of Mariani, specially imparting higher education. The Mariani College was brought under deficit system in 1975. The college took a giant step with a group of local enthusiastic people to introduce Science Stream in 1993. Now the college enjoys the distinction of having three full-fledged streams namely Arts, Commerce and Science with major in various subjects. The college has two campuses i.e. Old and New Campus. Science and Commerce streams are still running in old campus.

At present, Mariani College is a full-fledged Provincialised College and occupying a vital position under the Dibrugarh University almost in all spheres of academic performances as well as in the area of sports and culture. Many students of this college are now strewn over different parts of N.E. India, and abroad with commendable positions.

The college is already visited by the NAAC team for Re-accreditation in the last quarter in the month of April, 2017. The NAAC awarded B+ Grade accreditation with 2.53 institutional C.G.P.A.

With long 50 years experience, the college is imparting quality education among all with the help of a bunch of experienced and highly qualified teachers. At present, the college has intake capacity of 2000 students covering all the streams.

GENERAL RULES FOR DISCIPLINE AMONG STUDENTS

- [1] The students admitted to the College must abide by all rules and regulations as prescribed by the College Authority. Violation of rules and regulations, irregular attendance, discourtesy to the teachers and office staff, adoption of unfair means in the Examination Hall are some of the offences which may make students liable for disciplinary action like termination of scholarship, non-award of College certificate / diploma, forced transfer and even expulsion from the college.
- [2] The courses of study in Mariani College are full time courses. No student can take any other full time course concurrently.
- [3] Use of Mobile phone inside the campus is strictly prohibited. Disciplinary action will be taken to those students who violate this rule and a fine will be imposed as determined by the Authority.
- [4] The students must on uniform while they are in the campus and keep their identity card invariably.
- [5] The student must keep their bi-cycles, or any other vehicles in specified place for stand/ parking.
- [6] If any Poster, Notice or Papers relating to certain information requires to be pasted inside the College campus one must get prior approval from the Principal.

ADMISSION DETAILS

Dibrugarh University has introduced the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) in under graduate level in all affiliated colleges under the University from the Academic Session 2019-2020. The semester course will not continue except the existing last two semesters (5th & 6th). Students must get themselves admitted in every odd (i.e. 1st, 3rd and 5th) semester. Detailed information regarding semester and CBCS course may be obtained in the college office.

Admission Procedure :

- (a) The dates for interview-cum-admission are notified in the College Notice Board and Website of the institution. The Schedules are also notified through local dailies in time.
- (b) Prospectus and Application Forms for admission can be obtained through online mode. Students must produce original mark sheets, certificates etc. at the time of counselling. Admission to the college is made purely in order of merit and governed by the State Government Rules and College Admission Rules. *Selected students have to admit in various programmes through online admission process by clicking the link mentioned in the college website.*

Admission Criterion :

- (a) For admission for **Higher Secondary First Year Class**, a student must pass the HSLC or equivalent examination recognized by the Board or Council.
- (b) **Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) :**
A student passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, or an equivalent examination (10+2) from recognized board.
- (c) **Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) :**
A student passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in science stream of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, or an equivalent examination (10+2) from recognized board.

For admission into B.Sc. in Chemistry and Physics Honours, a candidate must pass the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in science stream of Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, or an equivalent examination with passing Mathematics as a subject.
- (d) **Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) :**
For admission into B.Com., a student who passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) of Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, or an equivalent examination (10+2) from recognized board.

CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

Dibrugarh University, Assam has introduced Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) from the academic session 2019-2020 in under-graduate level.

About Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)

CBCS means Choice Based Credit System, is a flexible system of learning. **CREDIT** defines the quantum of contents/syllabus prescribed for a course and determines the number of hours of instruction required.

Opportunity of CBCS :

1. Learn at their own pace.
2. Choose electives from a wide range of Elective Courses offered for the programme.
3. Undergo additional courses and acquire more than the required number of credits.
4. Adopt an inter-disciplinary approach in learning.
5. Make best use of the expertise of available faculty.

Credit :

CREDIT defines the quantum of contents/syllabus prescribed for a course and determines the number of hours of instruction required per week. Thus, normally in each of the course, credits will be assigned on the basis of the number of lectures/tutorials/laboratory work and other forms of learning required to complete the course contents in a 14–15 weeks schedule :

- (i) 1 Lecture per week = 1 Hour duration per week = 1 Credit
- (ii) 1 Tutorial per week = 1 Hour duration per week = 1 Credit
- (iii) 1 Practical per week = 2 Hours duration per week = 1 Credit

NOTE : The lecture sessions and tutorials shall not be substituted with any other activities like Seminars, Group Discussion etc.

Semester Duration :

- (i) **Odd Semester** : June – November (including end-semester examination and semester breaks)
- (ii) **Even Semester** : December – May (including end-semester examination and semester breaks)

Course Structure :

Under CBCS system student have to study 3 different types of courses in B.Sc./ B.A. honours programme. **The traditional concept 'Paper' is replaced by course.**

Core Course (CC) :

The courses are to be compulsorily studied as a core requirement for the programme. For B.A./B.Sc. honours. There shall be 14 courses of 6 credits (Core courses are similar to previous Major courses.)

Elective Course (EC) :

There shall be two types of Elective Courses (EC) –

Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) :

There courses are Intra Departmental. There shall be 4 courses of 6 credits. The DSE shall be in 5th and 6th Semester.

Generic Elective (GE) :

The Generic Elective courses are inter departmental in nature and are similar to that of pass courses of previous semester system. There shall be 4 courses of 6 credits. The Generic Elective shall be in 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Semester.

The students shall have to choose minimum numbers of DSE and GE in every semester as prescribed in the course structure.

Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) :

Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) are the courses based upon the content that leads to knowledge enhancement. These courses shall be inter disciplinary in nature. There shall be two types of AEC courses :

- (i) Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) : There shall be three courses of 2 credit each. i.e. (a) Communicative English, (b) Alternative English/Communicative Hindi/MIL, (c) Environmental Sciences. AECC shall be in 1st & 2nd Semester.

Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) :

These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value based and / or skill based knowledge. The main purpose of these courses is to provide students life skills in hands on mode so as to in case their employability. SEC shall be in 3rd & 4th Semester. There shall be 2 courses with 2 credit each.

The Institution offers following Skill Enhancement Course :

1. Travel & Tourism Management
2. National Service Scheme (NSS)
3. Vermi Compost.

Identity Card :

Students will get an Identity Card at the time of admission. They must keep their I-Card with them within the college campus. The college authority may asked for Identity Card whenever it feels necessary and any student fails to produce the same will be liable for punishment. Loss of Identity Card must be reported to the Principal immediately and apply for duplicate one after depositing necessary payment.

Library :

The College has a well stocked library with more than 20,000 text and reference books covering various subjects and of general interest. It also provides to the students some of the important journals, Magazines and Newspapers in the reading room. In addition to the central library, every department has a small library attached to it with some books and journals for regular use. The Commerce Department has a separate well-collected library maintained by Commerce Forum of Mariani College.

Moreover, it has a good collection of Encyclopedias relating to different subjects. For the benefit of library users, a xerox machine is also installed inside the Library.

Library Card is issued to students immediately after the admission is over. Students can borrow books against their Library Card for duration of 15 days only. The Library remains open from 10-00 A.M. to 4-00 P.M. in all working days and books are issued from 11-00 A.M. to 2-00 P.M. Only one book is issued against one card (two books for Major students). Mariani College Library took a positive step to facilitate the general public to utilize the books and journals every Saturday of each week in the afternoon session.

NCC / NSS / Scout & Guide :

The NCC is an organisation which provides a golden opportunity to students to develop leadership qualities, spirit de-corps and self confidence. The college provides the opportunity to join the NCC with a view to serve the society and the Nation as a whole. Similarly, the National Service Scheme (NSS) also provides opportunity to students to develop their personalities through community service. The students who have the commitment to serve the nation can join either NCC or NSS according to their interest. The college has some determination to open a new wing of Scout & Guide as per the guidelines of the Govt. of India as soon as possible and for this preparation is going on.

Laboratory :

The college has well-equipped laboratory in the department of Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology and Geography with all modern facilities to cope with the requirements of major standard.

Hostel Facility :

The college provides hostel facilities to the girls' students coming from distant places. 30 seats are available at present in the hostel.

Canteen :

The college has a canteen for providing refreshment to students/teachers as well as office staff at a subsidized rate within the college campus.

Sports :

Games and sports facilities are available in the college. The college provides facility of an indoor Badminton court and a gymnasium to the students.
