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MARIANI COLLEGE AT A GLANCE

It was in the year 1966, Mariani College was established by the sincerest initiatives of a good number of benevolent public and academicians of greater Mariani region. It was a humble effort for imparting higher education in a large locality, flanked mostly by Tea Gardens and villages of backward people. Establishment of Mariani College is a very vital and important addition in the academic scenario of Mariani, specially imparting higher education. The Mariani College was brought under deficit system in 1975. The college took a daring step with a group of local enthusiastic people to introduce Science Stream in 1993. Now College have the rare opportunity to have three full-fledged Streams of Arts, Commerce and Science with major in various subjects. The college has two Campuses i.e. old and New Campus. Science and Commerce streams are still running in old campus.

At present, Mariani College is a full fledged Provincialised College and occupying a vital position under the Dibrugarh University almost in all spheres of academic performances as well as in the area of sports and culture. Many students of this College are now strewn over different part of N.E. India, and abroad with commendable position.

The college is already visited by the NAAC team and their assessment is most encouraging. Moreover, effort has already been made for Re-accreditation of Mariani College by NAAC in the last quarter in the month of September 2015.

With long 49 years experience the college is imparting quality education among all with the help of a bunch of experience and highly qualified teachers. At present the college has intake capacity of 1500 students covering all the streams.

COURSES OF STUDY

The college imparts education in Higher Secondary and Undergraduate level covering all the three stream. A few professional courses are also introduced with the financial assistance and recognition from the UGC.

Courses of Study :

- i) Two year Higher Secondary Course in Arts, Commerce and Science.
- ii) Three year Degree in Arts, Commerce and Science.
- iii) Professional Course

1. Travel and Tourism Management.
2. Computer Application Career Course.

All the professional Course normally starts from September every year. Details of Course fees and syllabus can be had from the office during the month of August.

COMBINATION OF SUBJECTS

HIGHER SECONDARY (ARTS) :

1. ENGLISH is Compulsory
2. Modern Indian Language (MIL) (Compulsory)

Assamese, Bengali, Alternative English and Hindi.

3. Student can select maximum 3 (Three) subjects from the list of Subjects given below.

1 (One) can offer one additional subject as fourth subject.

(1) Economics, (2) Political Science, (3) History, (4) Geography, (5) Education,

(6) Advance language (Assamese & Bengoli).

Student who secure 50% or above marks in Geography will only be permitted.

There will be only 250 seats for Higher Secondary Classes in Arts Stream. (Student secured 40% marks or above will only be allowed to take admission.) Admission will be strictly on merit basis following Govt. Reservation Policy.

STREAM COMMERCE :

Compulsory Subject :

- i) English.
- ii) Modern Indian language (MIL)/Alt. English. MIL includes Bengali, Assamese, Hindi.
- iii) Accountancy.
- iv) Business Studies.

In addition to the above, students may select any two subjects from the following as Elective three and four.

STREAM SCIENCE:

In addition to Compulsory Subject English and MIL or Alternative English Student opted for Science Stream need to select any three subjects as elective and 1 (one) subject as Fourth Subject if desire from the following list of Subjects.

1. Physics 2. Chemistry 3. Mathematics 4. Biology 5. Computer Science.

(N.B) Environmental Studies is a Compulsory Subject for all the three Stream of the Higher Secondary first year Courses.

It is to be noted that the subject selected in the H.S. First year should be Continued in the second year also and under no circumstance alteration of subjects will be allowed.

UNDER GRADUATE COURSES

As per the Dibrugarh University regulation for the BA/B.Sc/B.Com & programmes in the Semester System 2010, Semester System shall be effective from 2011-2012 Academic Session for the Course of Study for the Degree of Bachelor of Arts (BA, Bachelor of Science (B.Sc) & Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com) Programmes which shall be of 3 (three) years duration in 6 (Six) Semesters.

Specifications :

- a. **Semester** : The word "Semester" is used to mean a half-yearly programme or term of studies.
- b. **In-semester** : The word "In-semester" is used to refer to the continuous studies and evaluations within the half-yearly programme.
- c. **End Semester** : The word "End-semester" is used to refer to the terminal processes of examinations and evaluations at the end of but within the half-yearly programme.

d. Semester Classifications :

- A) 1st, 3rd & 5th Semesters - Odd Semesters : July 01- Dec 31
- B) 2nd, 4th & 6th Semesters - Even Semesters : Jan 01 - June 30

Admission Criteria for admission into the 1st Semester :

- a) **Bachelor of Arts (BA)** : A student who has passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) of Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC), or an equivalent examination (10+2) recognized as such by the University, shall be eligible for admission into the First Semester of the Six Semester Degree Course in Arts in Semester System.

b) Bachelor of Science (B.Sc) : A student who has passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Science of Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC), or an equivalent examination (10+2) recognized as such by the University, shall be eligible for admission into the First Semester of the Six Semester Degree Course in Science in Semester System.

c) Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com) : A student who has passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Commerce of Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC), or an equivalent examination (10+2) recognized as such by the University, shall be eligible for admission into the First Semester of the Six Semester Degree Course in Commerce Semester System.

Structure of Courses of the Programmes :

All BA, B.Sc & B.Com Programmes shall have the following components, viz.

- i) Compulsory Courses :** These courses are the compulsory courses for all students of the programme concerned.
- ii) Major Courses/ Speciality :** Major/Speciality courses shall be chosen by the students. The Courses shall be optional and non-mandatory.
- iii) Non-Major Courses:** Non-Major Courses shall be chosen by the students, who do not opt for major courses.
- iv) Skill-based Courses :** A skill based course shall be mandatory for all students pursuing Non-Major BA and B.Sc Programmes. The college will offer the Skill-based courses as per own infrastructure and human resource feasibility.

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT :

Internal Assessment shall be compulsory components under the Course programme of semester programme for B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Courses. Programme for Internal Assessment different tools may be employed such as objective Test, Written Test, Group discussion, Paper presentation etc. suitable to the Course. The marks allotted for Internal Assessment (20%) in each Course shall be based on the following :

- a) Sessional Examination I and II 50% of the marks allotted for Internal Assessment.
- b) Seminar/Group discussion 25% of the marks allotted for Internal Assessment.
- c) Attendance 25% of allotted or Internal Assessment.

Provided that one (1) mark for attendance shall be awarded to the candidates falling under NON Collegiate Category within the range of 70% to less than 80% attendance who are allowed to appear in the end Semester examination of the concerned Semester w.e.f. 2013-14 academic session.

ATTENDANCE/UNIT TEST:

Student must be regular in their attendance and must secure 80% or more attendance in their respective classes. Failing to obtain the requisite percentage of attendance students shall not be permitted to sit for the End-Semester examination in each course. The Percentage of attendance is applicable in respect of Higher Secondary students too.

Regular Unit Test for all the classes of all the Streams will be managed by respective departments. Attendance in all the Unit Test is strictly compulsory and promotional assessment will be made on the basis of the performance in each tests held from time to time.

IDENTITY CARD:

Students will get an Identity Card at the time of admission. They must keep their I-Card with them within the College campus. The college authority may asked for I-Card whenever it feels necessary and any student fails to produce the same will be liable for punishment. Loss of I-Card must be reported to the Principal immediately and apply for duplicate one after depositing necessary payment.

LIBRARY:

The College has a well-stocked library with more than 30,000 text and reference books covering various subjects and general interest. It also provides to the students some of the important Journals, Magazines and Newspapers in the Reading Room. In addition to the Central Library every Department has a small Library attached to it with some books and Journals for regular use. The Commerce Department has a separate wellcollected Library maintained by Commerce Forum of Mariani College.

Library Card is issued to students immediately after the admission is over. Students can borrow books against their Library Card for duration of 15 days only. The Library remains open from 10-00 A.M. to 4-00 P.M. in all working days and books are issued from 11-00 A.M. to 2-00 P.M. Only one book is issued against one card (two books for Major students) Efforts are on to computerize the Library with all modern amenities linking with other modern Libraries of International Standard. Mariani College Library took a positive Step to facilitate the General Public to utilize the books and journals every Saturday of each week in the afternoon session.

LABORATORY:



1. A candidate shall be declared as passed a course when he/she secures at least 40% marks in each course in the End-Semester with at least 40% marks in each course in aggregate in the In- and End Semester Examinations separately.
2. A candidate who fails or does not appear in one or more courses of any end semester examinations upto Sixth Semester shall be provisionally promoted to the next higher semester with the failed course as carry over course (s). Such candidates will be eligible to appear in the carry over course in the next regular examinations of those course.
3. A candidate shall be entitled to a maximum of three chances to clear a course.
4. A student must pass all his/her semester examinations within 5 (Five) years from the date of admission to the First Semester of any programme.
5. A candidate shall be declared to have passed the Six -Semester Degree BA/B.Sc/B.Com Programme provided he/she has passed all the Semesters and in all the Courses separately.
6. Since the Semester system involves continuous assessment, there shall be no scope for a student to appear as a private candidate in any programme in this system.
